The sale of Chametz is conducted between a representative of the Shul, the Rabbi, and a non-Jew. After Pesach, the Chametz is repurchased by the Rabbi. If you would like Rabbi Orrin to sell your Chametz, please fill out the form below and email it to rabbi@sojc.org. Traditionally, we could also meet in person to effect the Kinyan, the “transfer” or “sale.” However, with times being what they are, if you’d like to set up a Zoom appointment to have a virtual Kinyan and meet personally with the Rabbi, please let Rabbi Orrin know in your email.

Please be sure to sell your Chametz no later than Wednesday, April 8th by 12pm by emailing this form to the Rabbi.

I further state that the Chametz covered by the agreement will be stored away and not used by me during the period commencing no later than 12pm on Wednesday, April 8, 2020, and ending no earlier than 9:11 pm on Thursday, April 16, 2020.
